Accessibility situation in the Zooplankton Information System at the moment

The Finnish Environment Institute has assessed the accessibility of the online service from the perspective of WCAG 2.1 A and AA level accessibility requirements. The online service mainly meets the requirements.

Accessibility requirements that are not met by the online service

The taxon listing table + button opens the sex and stage table of that taxon. This table is not visible to the screen reader. Users can download data to Excel from the button on the page (Load taxon list / Load sex/stage list).

The following cases are covered by the Unreasonable Burden Exemption under Article 5 of the Accessibility Directive:

- map services

The following functions are not available because they are not subject to accessibility legislation:

- map services

However, some map service features, such as location selection, are available through text lists.

When we update the service or add new content to the service, we strive to make them accessible.
