

Description of service

The zooplankton information system is a service maintained by the Finnish Environment Institute (SYKE).

The zooplankton information system contains quantitative zooplankton data from coastal water monitoring. The Species Information section also covers the Baltic Sea species.

The use of storage functions related to the system requires a written agreement with the Finnish Environment Institute.

The online service is published in Finnish and English.

The pages produced by the service have their own Help function at the top right, which provides guidance on the functions of that page.

Connections

The service is part of Hertta environmental information service package.

The species information section is based on the Laji.fi system of the Finnish Biodiversity Information Facility (FinBiF)

The system includes a separate calculation program EnvZoopl for storing microscopy results.

Browsers, terminals and software

The site is responsive and the content scales according to the terminal. The layout of the site is at its best when using the latest browser versions. The site can also be used with older versions of the browser, but in that case not all features may be fully available.

File downloads produce both Excel and csv format files.
